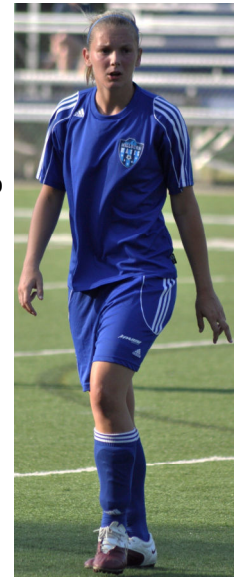

**Magic Duo Named to 2010 WPSL All-East Teams**  
**Millburn, NJ - August 2nd, 2010**



Two Millburn Magic stars have been selected by the Women's Premier Soccer League as part of the organization's 2010 All-East First and Second Teams after playing vital roles in the squad's second playoff campaign in as many seasons.

**Kayleigh Hines** (right), the former England youth team player who was named to the WPSL Team of the Week last month, was handed a place in the All-East First Team. The Arsenal Ladies graduate stood out in the league after successive strong performances, winning nearly every 50-50 challenge in midfield while also playing a vital part in Millburn's attacking play.



Hines proved to be particularly brilliant in the air and was always confident when both holding the ball and passing it to teammates, while her positive conduct on the field set a great example, consistently promoting fair play.

She joins three players from the 2010 championship-winning Boston Aztec Breakers Reserves (F Leah Blayney, D Anna Caniglia and D Kelly Lawrence), two from the Lancaster Inferno (F Erin Hench and MF/F Teresa Rynier), three from the Long Island Fury (MF Lorraine Quinn, D Alyssa Pember and GK Brittany Anghel) and two from the Boston Aztec 23s (MF Jess Luscinski and D Katherine Donnelly).



Hines is joined by Magic defender **Mallory Baker** (left) in the All-East accolades, named to the Second Team after a great performance at the back of the field in her debut season for Millburn. Baker, who will be returning to the University of Maryland's prestigious soccer program this fall after starting 21 of the Terps' 22 games in midfield and helping her college to nine shutouts last season, was strong under pressure and steadfast in many key games. These included a 1-0 win against last year's national champions the Long Island Fury and a flawless defensive stand against South Jersey United in the closing stages of the campaign, when the Magic won 4-0.

Baker was named alongside two players from New York Athletic Club (F Jevne Reid and D Heather Havron), two from the New England Mutiny (MF Jenny Maurer and MF/D Becky Gundling), two from BuxMont Torch (MF Meredith Crowell and MF/F Ashley Lachappelle), two from ASA Chesapeake Charge (MF Kelly Hammond and GK Mary Casey), Boston Aztec U23 forward Brooke Knowlton and South Jersey United defender Courtney Dougherty.
