**More Familiar Faces Return to the Magic
Millburn, NJ—January 25th, 2012**



The Millburn Magic have already started to build an excellent team for the 2012 season after a number of players confirmed their inclusion in the squad following successful trials over the winter break. After announcing their first addition - **Laura Kurash**, a Magic veteran and all-WPSL choice in 2011 - a number of other players have added their names to the roster once again.

Katy Fissel, who has just come from her most impressive season to date with Wilkes, is one of them. A native of Madison - where the Magic have played their home games for two seasons - the midfield playmaker was named to the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Division III All-Mid-Atlantic Region team this season after finishing fourth in scoring with 10 points (3G, 4A) after starring in 13 of the 17 games for the Lady Colonels. She also earned Player of the Week honors during the year.

Mallory Sheer will also come back to the Magic, after reaching the Centennial Conference Final with the Gettysburg Bullets. Sophomore Sheer helped her team to a regular season 11-6 record and an 8-2 conference finish, playing in 16 games during the campaign. The Bullets traveled through the playoffs until the excellent #4 Johns Hopkins beat them in the final.

Finally, **Becky Krakora** will return to Millburn after starting all 15 games for the Bowdoin Polar Bears, taking them to the NESCAC Quarterfinals - proving herself to be as indispensable to her college as she did to the Magic in the 2011 WPSL campaign.
